

CUKUROVA UNIVERSITY ÇAMLITEPE GUESTHOUSE DORMITORY RULES AND REGULATIONS

Before you sign the contract for accommodation, students need to check the room out carefully and be sure that everything is in good condition. Since students will be responsible for any probable damage occurred during their stay, they will be responsible for the cost of damage.

DORMITORY RULES

These rules and regulations have been established by the International Office to inform students of their responsibilities within the dormitories. These rules and regulations are designed to promote and maintain an atmosphere conducive to dormitory living. All students are responsible for knowing and adhering to these rules and regulations. Çukurova University reserves the right to ask you to empty the room in case of not obeying the rules.

1. NOISE: Each student is responsible for keeping noise levels to a minimum at all times inside the rooms. Noise levels should be low enough so as not to disturb others. It is not allowed to party in the dormitory after 22:30 pm.

Each student will be aware of the following quiet hours: Sunday through Thursday 10:30pm-08:00am

Friday and Saturday 11:59pm-10:00am

- **2. ALCOHOL:** The alcohol consumption and sale is not allowed on campus area.
- **3. SECURITY:** Students may not allow people who are not their guests into the building. Persons are not permitted to be in the dormitory without being a resident of the dormitory or being escorted by a resident. No person will be permitted to enter a student's room without the expressed consent of the students who live in that room.

Students may not climb through windows.

Students may not borrow keys from each other or loan keys to anyone. Students must return keys immediately upon check out or reassignment and must report any lost or stolen keys.

- **4. DISORDERLY CONDUCT:** Behavior that is disruptive to orderly dormitory living is prohibited. This includes, but is not limited to, throwing items in the hallways, bouncing balls inside the rooms, fighting, pranks, or any other behavior which may cause physical injury or is potentially dangerous to the health and wellbeing of residents, including threats or acts of self-injury (such as attempted suicide) or injury to other students.
- **5. INTIMIDATION/INVASION OF PRIVACY:** Threatening or abusive behavior will not be tolerated; this includes, but is not limited to, sexual, racial or religious harassment, intimidation, hazing, stalking, prank or unwanted telephone calls, invasion of privacy, or any other behavior that creates a hostile living environment.
- **6. OBJECTS FROM WINDOWS & BALCONIES:** Throwing, pouring, or dropping anything (including keys) from windows or balconies is strictly prohibited.

- **7. DESTROYING or DAMAGING PROPERTY**: Damage to University premises or property or property of any other person is prohibited. All students are expected to care for buildings and furnishings. Costs of damage in a room will be assessed against each occupant of the room. Cost for damage to public areas, including but not limited to, bathrooms, stairways, kitchenettes, laundry areas, lounges, and study halls will be assessed against each occupant.
- **8. FIREARMS, WEAPONS, FIREWORKS, EXPLOSIVES, and DANGEROUS CHEMICALS**: Possession and/or use of fireworks (including sparklers), weapons, dangerous chemicals or explosives of any kind is prohibited.
- **9. VISITS AND ROOM GUESTS**: Students who have overnight guests (either from their home country or family) **are required to confirm with** the Reception minimum one week before. Students are responsible for and can be held accountable for the behavior of their guests. Students must escort their guest(s) at all times. Students of a room may be held responsible for the behavior that takes place inside the room whether or not the students are present. Students are not allowed to have visitors in their room unless they inform the reception. The visitors must leave the guesthouse before 22:00 o'clock.
- **10. FURNITURE**: All furniture assigned to student rooms must remain in the room, and therefore, no furniture is to be removed by students from rooms.
- **11. ROOM-CHANGES**: Students may not change room without receiving official authorization from the reception or International Office.
- **12. CHECK-OUT PROCEDURE:** Students should check-out from the guesthouse between 08:00-17:00 in the daytime.
